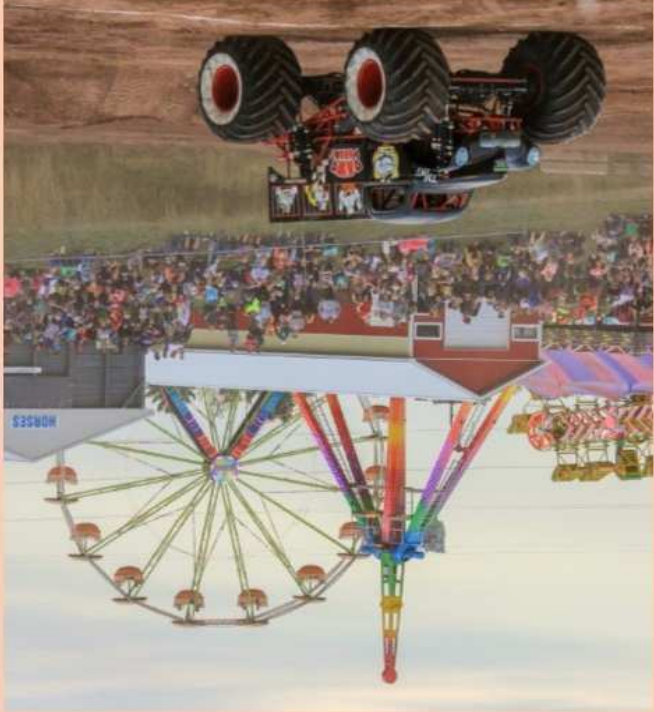

To get to the fairgrounds from US 41 in Hancock, turn north on Ethel Avenue and west on Ingot Street OR from M203 turn north on Birch Street.
