**RULES:**

1. All birds shall have been owned for at least 30 days. No birds will be accepted that have been purchased and brought in just for exhibiting at the fair.
2. Exhibitors will be allowed to enter **three** animals in each class with a maximum of **30 animals total per farm**.
3. A separate exhibit shall be entered if exhibiting in both OPEN & YOUTH classes.
4. All birds shall be a recognized breed except meat classes.
5. Poultry judges use the American "Standard of Perfection" publication as a guide to judging all poultry.
6. An entry in this department does not guarantee an award. If in the opinion of the superintendent & judge, the exhibit is not worthy, no premium will be awarded, regardless of number of entries in a class.
7. Game birds include pheasants. Birds should be at least 4 months old except in meat classes.
8. Infectious Laryngotrachitis (ILT) vaccinated birds are not allowed on the fairgrounds.
9. All poultry, except waterfowl, shall be dusted for lice by exhibitor before bringing to fair (ideally one month before).
10. No bird can be put in a cage until tested for pullorum-typhoid and the test is negative. The Superintendent has to then approve it to be put in the proper cage after inspection.
11. If you have a large number of entries please contact the superintendent to set up a time to have your birds tested for pullorum-typhoid before the fair.
12. Exhibitors desiring to dispose of their breeding stock may post a sign on the cage after judging. The sign shall include name of seller, phone number, and asking price and attach to the cage after judging has taken place. Animals shall stay until release time. Sale of animals is between seller and buyer. The fair board is not responsible for any sales. Sale of any other animals should be cleared with the Superintendent.
13. All poultry exhibitors will be responsible for daily cage cleaning. Daily cleaning shall be done by 11 am each morning and report to the superintendent when finished. Failure to

clean cages will result in a fine of \$1 per cage per day and will be deducted from your premium. Exhibitors are encouraged to work in cooperation with other exhibitors on "sharing" cleaning. **If sharing duties, owner of animals shall leave a list with superintendent giving permission of listed persons to care for their animals** along with phone #.

14. But cleaning shall be completed between set times. Preparation (adding tar paper and litter) and clean up of cages at end of fair (removal of litter and tar paper) are required.
15. Failure to comply with any of the above rules will result in the forfeit of premium money. Any lack of care of an exhibitor's animal will result in the exhibitor being requested to remove their exhibit and forfeit their premium money. (See general fair rules and regulations.)

**Rules:**

1. Exhibitors will be allowed to enter **three** animals in each class with a maximum of **30 animals total per farm.**
2. A separate exhibit shall be entered if exhibiting in both OPEN & YOUTH classes.
3. Rabbits will be judged by American Rabbit Breeders Association standard of perfection.
4. Mixed breed rabbits may only be entered in pet rabbit classes.
5. Exhibitors desiring to dispose of their breeding stock may post a sign on the cage after judging. The sign shall include the name of seller, phone number, and asking price and attach to the cage after judging has taken place. Animals shall stay until release time. Sale of animals is between seller and buyer. The fair board is not responsible for any sales. Sale of any other animals should be cleared with Superintendent.
6. All rabbit exhibitors will be responsible for daily cage cleaning. Daily cleaning shall be done by 11 am each morning and report to the superintendent when finished. Failure to clean cages will result in a fine of \$1 per cage per day and will be deducted from your premium. Exhibitors are encouraged to work in cooperation with other exhibitors on “sharing” cleaning, but cleaning shall be completed between set times. Preparation (adding tar paper and litter) and clean up of cages at end of fair (removal of litter and tar paper) are required.
7. Failure to comply with any of the above rules will result in the forfeit of premium money. Any lack of care of an exhibitor’s animal will result in the exhibitor being requested to remove their exhibit and forfeit their premium money. (See general fair rules and regulations.)
8. **If sharing duties, owner of animals shall leave a list with superintendent** giving permission of listed persons to care for their animals, along with phone number.
