

11. Samples shall be held secure and cold until transferred to the laboratory.
Note: Urine may be frozen; blood shall be kept refrigerated and never be frozen.
12. Any discarded needles should be placed in an approved "Sharps" container by the veterinarian/veterinarian technician.
13. When all sample collection has been completed, fill out the "Sample Transmittal Packing List." The packing list shall identify the tag number of all samples included in the case. Enclose the completed "Sample Transmittal Packing List", and unused supplies and regenerated/refrozen freezer packs in the case and seal it with the provided intact case seal.

After Sample Collection is Completed

1. Transport samples to the lab either in person or by overnight express. Arrange samples to arrive at the lab during normal business hours (7:30 am-5:00 pm, Monday through Friday). The lab is located on the campus of Michigan State University at: 1615 South Harrison Road, East Lansing, MI 48823.
2. Collect and retain signed Animal Certification Forms and the remaining portion of the completed "Sample Tag".

Note: Both of these documents should be kept in a secure place for cross-reference when sample results are received. In the event of a positive result these documents shall be kept as evidence.
